What is expected of students?

- Seven courses of study (Aug-March)
- 8 month program
- 7 assignments and seven final exams
- A final essay
- All course work is only available online and all assignments must be submitted electronically. All final exams are taken online using a private testing service.
- Mandatory Meetings
 - District Assembly
 - District Conference
 - Other meetings as determined by the Academy Dean.
- Timely submission of all assignments. Courses last one month and must be completed during that time. The final exam for each course must be taken before proceeding to the next course. Students falling 30+ days behind may be dropped from the program with the option to complete the program the following year.



How does someone enroll?

- Admission is by nomination only.
- Past Presidents, Presidents-Elect, and Presidents-Nominee are eligible for admission as are others who are nominated by the DG or DGE.
- Nominations may be submitted by DG, DGE, DGN, PDG's, AG's, and Academy Instructors
- Class is limited to 20 students.
- Students must complete a Skills survey and successfully complete Course #1: Communications before being admitted to the program.
